Sub: Extension of approval of affiliation of School of Law, Sharda University, Greater Noida for imparting five year BA. LLB, B.Com LLB, BBA. LLB, B.Sc. LLB (Integrated) and Six year B.Tech. LLB (Integrated) law courses.

Sir,

Legal Education Committee at its meeting held on 3rd May, 2014 considered the inspection report of the above mentioned college. After consideration, Committee made the following recommendations:-

The Legal Education Committee considered the inspection report submitted by the inspection team. After consideration, Committee is of the view that School of Law, Sharda University, Greater Noida be granted extension of approval of affiliation for running five year BA LL.B, B.Com LL.B and BBA LL.B courses with existing strength for a period of two years i.e. for the academic years 2014-2015 and 2015-2016 subject to the following conditions.

Further the Committee is of the view that as per Section 7 (1) (i) of the Advocates Act, 1961, Sharda University, Greater Noida be granted recognition for the purpose of conferring the degree in five year B.Sc LLB(integrated) and six year BTech:LLB(integrated) and fresh temporary approval of affiliation for running five year B.Sc. LL.B (integrated) and six year B.Tech LL.B (integrated) with an intake of two sections of 60 students in each section in each course for a period of one year i.e. for the academic year 2014-2015 subject to the following conditions :-



1. They should appoint atleast one more M.Tech teacher for six year B.Tech LL.B course and increase it with continuance for subsequent year, keeping in view of Schedule III.
2. College should ensure the payment of salary to principal and teachers as per Rules 22 schedule III, Part IV of BCI Rules.
3. The institution is directed to upgrade the library by investing minimum Rs. 50,000/- per year per stream.
4. Teacher Student ratio shall be maintained as per Schedule-III, Rule-11, Clause-17, Part-IV of Bar Council of India Rules.
5. Institution should submit affidavit in compliance to the above conditions within three months.

The above recommendations were considered by the Bar Council of India at its meeting held on 9th May, 2014 and accepted the same.

College authorities are also required to apply to the Bar Council of India for further extension of approval of affiliation six months in advance before expiry of the period of approval of affiliation granted by the Bar Council of India i.e. on or before 31st December, 2014 for 5 year B.Sc. LLB (Integrated) and 6 year B.Tech. LLB (Integrated) law courses and 31st December, 2015 for 5 year BA. LLB, B.Com. LLB and BBA. LLB law courses failing which a late fee will be charged.
