### About Sharda University

Sharda University, Greater Noida, is a NAAC A+ accredited private State University established in 2009. The university has 14 schools having 25 departments imparting instructions in almost all disciplines of pure & applied sciences, engineering & technology, management, social sciences & humanities, architecture, law, agriculture, education, media, film & entertainment, nursing, pharmacy, allied health science, dentistry, and medical sciences. It offers 130 programmes out of which 56 are at the Undergraduate level and 70 at the post graduate level. The university also offers a doctoral programme, diploma in Nursing and Pharmacy and a certificate course in English proficiency.

The university boasts of a comprehensive infrastructure aimed at enhancing the learning experience for students. It has a sprawling eco-friendly green campus of 62.7 acres with state-of-the-art built-up area of 3.30 lakh sq. meter, catering to nearly 15000 students, including approx. 12% international students from 65+ countries.

As per NIRF 2022-23 rankings, the university was placed at 87<sup>th</sup> position amongst all universities in India, with several specialized centres of research providing cutting-edge technologies and high-end analytical equipment for faculty and students. So far, the University has awarded 463 Ph.D degrees and has 55 granted and 378 published patents to its credit. Recognising the fact that the country today needs not only the job seekers but also job providers, the university has commissioned 'Sharda LaunchPad' that provides students and industry a platform with requisite infrastructure to convert their innovative ideas into products of societal development. Likewise, skill development has been emphasised and the idea of 'Make in India' has been given a new thrust. For experiential enrichment of the students, the University has introduced a credit based 'Community Connect Programme'. The university has recently set up Sharda University EPIPWA Skill Development Centre, as a platform to collaborate with industry, society and other agencies to develop agile and able workforce, which will lead to a strong community and nation.

Its 1200+ bedded Shara Care – The Health City offers complete healthcare comprising basic medical and surgical treatment, super-specialties, high-end diagnostic and therapeutic services through sophisticated equipment.








### INDUSTRIAL VISIT TO HAIER APPLIANCES INDIA PVT. LTD.

The event was marked by interactive sessions and practical demonstrations and successfully imparted knowledge on crucial aspects of BLS, including CPR techniques and emergency response protocols. Students actively engaged in hands-on practice, fostering confidence in their ability to respond effectively during critical situations. The training was conducted under the guidance of specialists from the Trained Nurses' Association of India, Central Institute of Nursing & Research & Elderly Care Home, Greater Noida.



### A HANDS-ON FABRICATION WORKSHOP

### HANDS-ON TRAINING ON BASIC LIFE SUPPORT

Sharda School of Nursing Science & Research (SSNSR), Sharda University organized Hands-on Training on Basic Life Support on May 1, 2023. Basic life support training skills save lives as it takes care of critical medical emergencies such as cardiac arrest management. Medical emergencies occur when least expected. The victim's survival depends on whether there is a skilled professional to provide the necessary care. The training to the students and staff was imparted on CPR to provide timely intervention, with this knowledge the rescuer can keep the victim alive for some time by maintaining blood circulation within the body, especially in terms of the vital organs.

### WORKSHOP ON INCLUSIVE EDUCATION AND AUTISM

The School of Education, Sharda University organised an immersive one-day workshop on 'Inclusive Education and Autism' in collaboration with Sri Aurobindo Society on April 10, 2023. The workshop sensitized the students of School of Education towards the needs and characteristics of learners with autism. It enabled them to recognize and identify children with autism and learn about the pedagogical practices to be more inclusive. It helped them create and understand those opportunities that have traditionally been denied to certain groups of students.

### INTERNATIONAL SEMINAR ON "AN OVERVIEW OF STATISTICAL META-ANALYSIS"

Department of Mathematics, Sharda School of Basic Sciences and Research, Sharda University had organized an International Seminar on "An Overview of Statistical Meta-Analysis" in collaboration with the "University of Maryland" on 3 June 2023. Meta-analysis is the statistical combination of results from two or more separate studies. Potential advantages of metaanalyses include an improvement in precision, the ability to answer questions not posed by individual studies, and the opportunity to settle controversies arising from conflicting claims. However, they also have the potential to mislead seriously, particularly if specific study designs, within-study biases, variation across studies, and reporting biases are not carefully considered.









### HOLI CUISINE: EXPLORING THE FLAVOURS AND TRADITIONS OF INDIA'S FESTIVAL OF COLOURS




### NATIONAL GIRL CHILD DAY






#### PHOTOGRAPHY CLUB
